## "TRANSSHIPMENT ASSESSMENT FEES"

- 1 All "uncollected assessments" prior to January 1, 1989, to be maived.
- 2 Future assessments, on and after January 1, 1989, to be invoiced and collected on the following basis:
  - a) On cransshipments of containers to "Palm Beach".
  - b) An assassment of \$25.00 per TEU and \$50.00 per FEU.
- 3 This assessment shall be reported and paid by each carrier and/or their Agent within forty-five (45) days after the container is delivered to Palm Beach.

It was further recommended that the Secretary of the Management-ILA Container Committee write a letter secting forth the foregoing.
